Please share this info with all your members fishing that may not get this email.

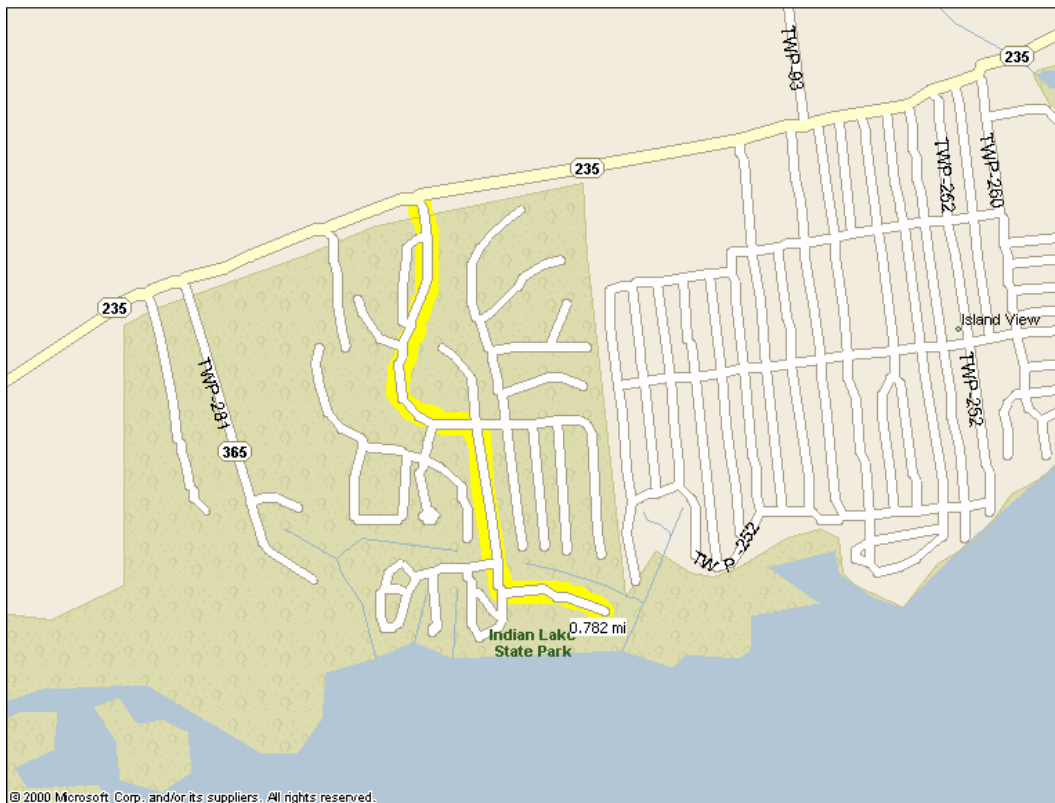
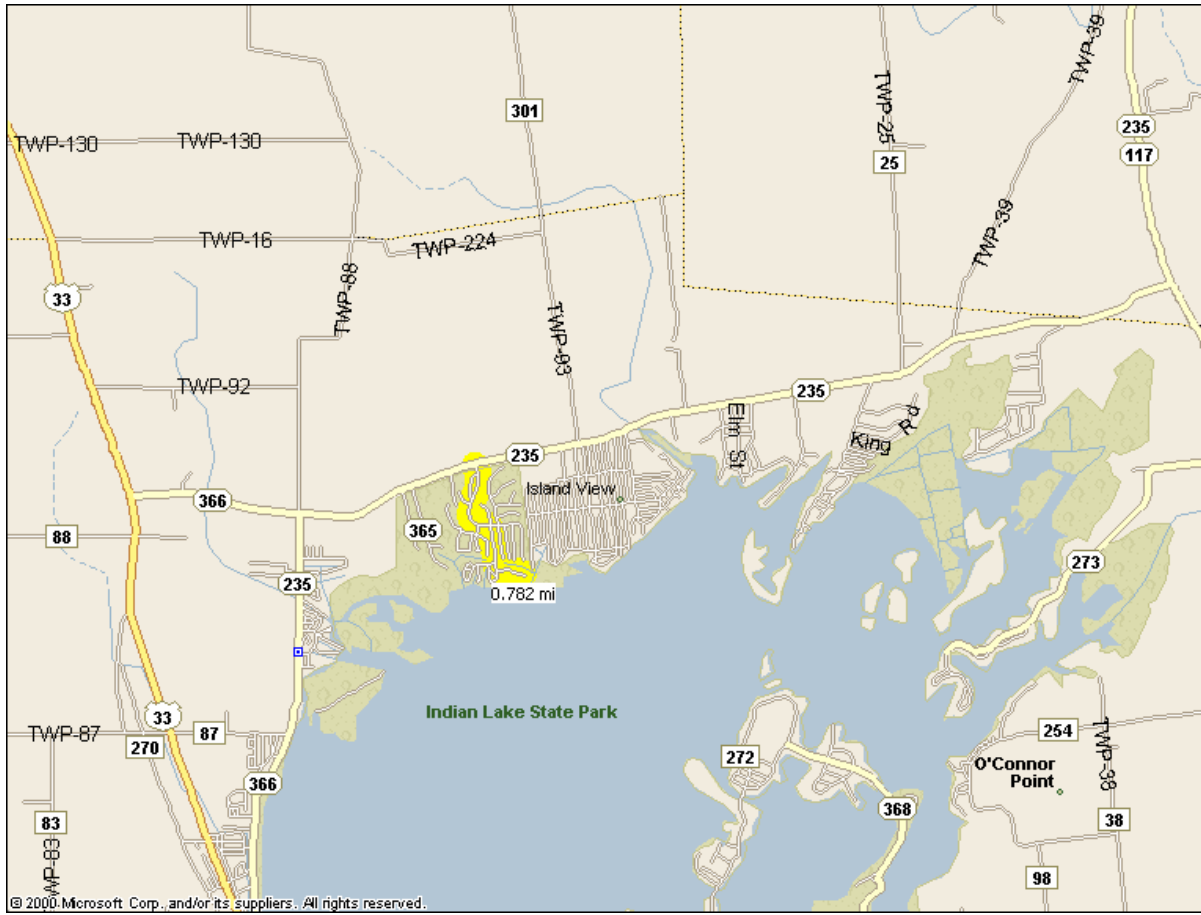
- **The ramp site is the State Campgrounds on the North side of the lake off of State Rt 235.**
This has been change from the original site of Mound wood.
- **You must be checked-in both days by 6:00AM and no later.**
- **Those of you that need to present up-dated insurance policies must do so at the ramp or you will not be allowed to use your boat.** Anyone bringing a back-up boat must have up to date insurance papers with them to be able to use their boat in case one of your other member's boats is out of commition for any reason, but please let Al or I (Mike) know this. I recommend that all boaters should keep a copy of your insurance papers in your boat at all times for your own benefit but not required for this tournament.
- **We will have a water weigh-in from at least 2 to 4 docks that will be marked.** The boater will weigh his fish in first and when he returns to the boat, than the non-boater may weigh his fish in. When the non-boater is done at weigh-in than he is to proceed to the tow vehicle and load the boat immediately. Those of you that might launch your boat from another ramp will move your boat a free dock area out of the way of the way in.
- **Any fish weighed in from the parking lot will not be weighed-in!**
- **Tournament weigh-in bags will only be used!!! *Not your own personal bags.***
- **Also make sure that your boat registration is up to date also.**
- Thanks to the Ohio Bass Federation we have additional prize money this year. Some of this due to the ticket sales of the boat raffle.
- Prize money break down
 - 1st. place \$925 plus a plaque
 - 2nd. place \$580 plus a plaque
 - 3rd. place \$460 plus a plaque
 - 4th. place \$230 plus a plaque
 - 5th place \$150 plus a plaque
 - Sat. Big Bass \$250
 - Sun. Big Bass \$250
 - Big Bass over all plaque

Total pay-out of \$2845.00

- Money winners will need to provide the following info to receive the prize money.
Full name, address and social security number for tax purposes. Anyone receiving over \$600 in prize money at Regionals, SQT's and Classic with a total over the \$600 will have to have a 1099 issued to them for tax purposes. This info will be sent to the OBCF Treasure so he can keep track of it and to do the necessary paper work.
- **If you have any protests or complaints to be file with Directors, it must be done prier to the closing of the pay-outs or it will not count.**
- **Non-boaters should pay a minimum of \$15 dollars to the boater of your club that you were teamed up with on paper work turned in.**
